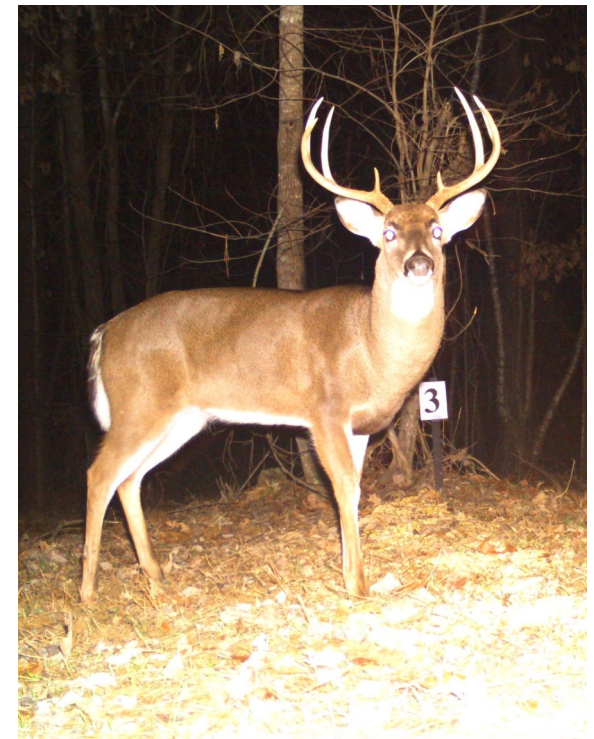

Game Camera Surveys and Forest Management for White-tailed Deer Workshop

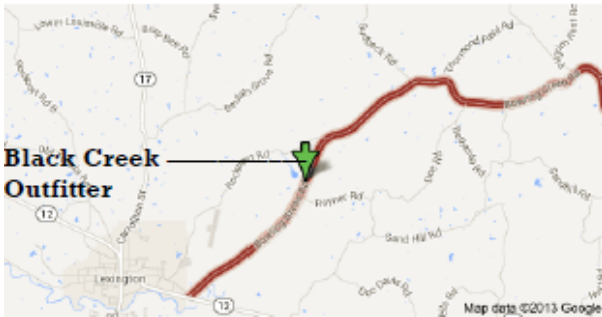
A workshop for private non-industrial forest landowners and their families.
