This event is being hosted by The Escape Ranch near Kenansville, Florida. The ranch is a privately owned non-commercial recreational property. The Escape Ranch has a long, rich history of premier quail hunting and land stewardship.

Approximately 6,000 acres are dedicated to wild bobwhite management while the remaining 8,000 acres is used for cattle grazing and some liberated quail management. As part of a regional study on bobwhites, Tall Timbers began an intensive study on the population ecology of bobwhites on the Ranch in 2005.
