Introduction to Hardwood Management Short Course

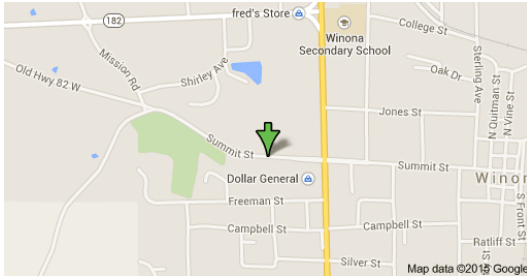
A short course for private non-industrial forest landowners and their families.
