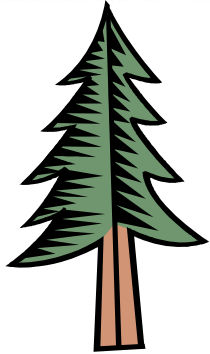

DESCRIPTION

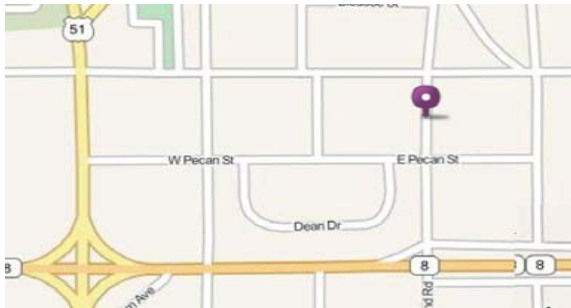

During the workshop participants will develop a partially completed written management plan. Forest certification programs such as Tree Farm and most government cost-share assistance programs require a written management plan.
