Managing Your Pine Plantation Short Course

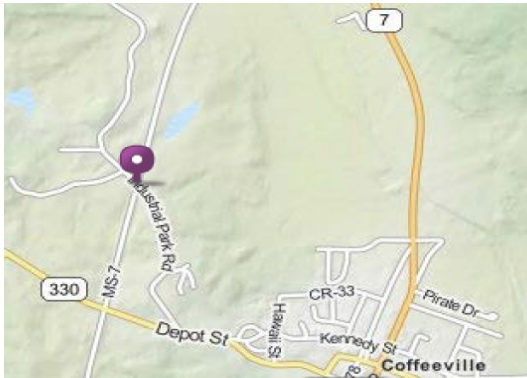
A short course for private non-industrial forest landowners and loggers.
