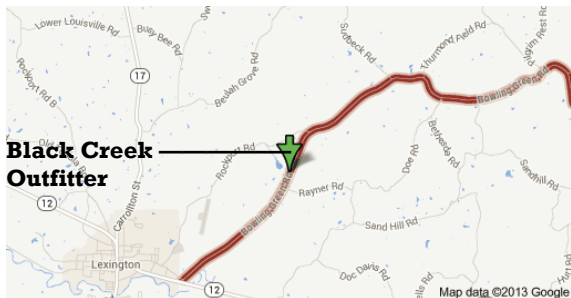
TREE IDENTIFICATION WORKSHOP
