

COLLEGE OF FOREST RESOURCES/FOREST AND WILDLIFE RESEARCH CENTER RESEARCH AWARD NOMINATION FORM

The Research Award is a distinction bestowed upon a research faculty member, within the College of Forest Resources (CFR), with a distinguished record of research recognized as original and innovative by peers, nationally, or preferably internationally, and outstanding contributions to the exchange of information with professionals, peers, and the general public.

One Research Award will be made annually and will be recognized at the Advisory Board Banquet typically held in the fall. Recipients will receive a one-time honorarium of \$1,500.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a research faculty member within a department in CFR/FWRC
- Research is recognized as original and innovative by peers, nationally, or preferably internationally
- Research is recognized as exemplary relative to its creative contribution to an interdisciplinary project (i.e. ability to look beyond individual disciplines in planning research)
- Research that will or has made an impact on socio-economic welfare or cultural growth regionally, nationally, or internationally
- Ongoing development and participation in national and international collaborative research projects of mutual interest
- Outstanding contributions to the exchange of information with professionals, peers, and the general public. Evidence of such contributions may include the writing and publication of a noteworthy book, serving as an editor or associate editor of a journal or book (serving as a coordinator of a national or international conference)

PROCEDURE:

- Nominations shall originate from the nominee's home department
- There will be one nominee from each department
- The nomination packet shall not exceed 7 pages and will include: this cover sheet, department head letter of support, an abridged CV (only last 3 years will be considered), and a maximum of three external and/or internal letters of support.
