The Teaching Award is a distinction bestowed upon a faculty member, within the College of Forest Resources (CFR), with a distinguished record of outstanding and innovative teaching techniques in the classroom and/or laboratory that create an active learning environment based on respect of diverse talents and ways of learning.

One Teaching Award will be made annually and will be recognized at the Advisory Board Banquet typically held in the fall. Recipients will receive a one-time honorarium of \$1,500.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a faculty member within a department in CFR/FWRC
- Outstanding and innovative teaching techniques in the classroom and/or laboratory that create an active learning environment.
- Excellence in producing effective measures of student learning through ongoing assessment and prompt feedback.
- Exemplary teaching methods that are based upon respect of diverse talents and ways of learning.
- Exemplary dedication to advising and teaching at the undergraduate, graduate, and/or continuing education levels.
- Outstanding concern and dedication to the professional/educational development of students; notable rapport and contact with students; a recognized role model for students.

PROCEDURE:

- Nominations shall originate from the nominee's home department
- There will be one nominee from each department
- The nomination packet shall not exceed 7 pages and will include: this cover sheet, department head letter of support, an abridged CV (only last 3 years will be considered), and a maximum of three external and/or internal letters of support.
