

## Special Edition Announcement

*Frontiers in Forests and Global Change* is seeking submissions for a special issue dedicated to the 21<sup>st</sup> Biennial Southern Silvicultural Research Conference (BSSRC). The primary focus of this special issue is forest management in the southeastern United States. Under this framework, the special issue will consider submissions dedicated to traditional silvicultural topics including forest productivity, prescribed fire, herbicide applications, natural regeneration, artificial regeneration, thinning, and forest restoration. In addition, the special issue encourages submissions that investigate how forest management impacts a diverse suite of topics including nutrient cycling, wildlife habitat, carbon management, and a variety of other prominent natural resource issues in the southeastern United States.
